CIS Secondary Swimming Championships conducted under NSW Swimming rules unless otherwise stated.

☆ CIS Team:

**Pathway** 

All swimmers who participate at the NSWCIS carnival should be available for selection in the CIS Team in the events in which they swim. Should this not be the case, individual association convenors should be notified so that they can inform the selectors prior to the meet.

Generally only those who compete at the CIS Championships will be eligible for selection in the CIS Secondary Swimming Team. Generally selections will be based on fastest 3 times per event and the NSWCIS Selection Policy (see Operational Guidelines). Students placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> must report to the Shane Gould Room room to register, purchase uniform and pay the levy. Secondary Swimmers selected to compete at NSW All Schools who withdraw without a medical certificate more than 1 week after the publication of the full CIS Swimming Team List will incur a fine of \$15.00 and may not be considered for further selection. Changes at the NSW All Schools Championships due to illness or injury will be at the discretion of the Team Managers.

**Multi Class selection** for the CIS team is subject to placing on the basis of classification and pathway qualifying standards, they are not necessarily the result of the actual race. Official Places will be posted on the result board.

The CIS team will be confirmed on the CIS website by Friday 10 May 2024.

☆ Eligibility NSW All Schools - maximum age for swimmers is turning 19 in the year of competition.

The CIS Team will compete at the NSW All Schools Swimming Championships Thursday 30 May – Friday 31 May 2024 at Sydney International Aquatic Centre, where a NSW

All Schools team will be selected.

☆ Uniform: Swimmers must fall in line with FINA rules and requirements.

CSSA Swim Cap must be worn: Available from CSSA Team Manager at event.
