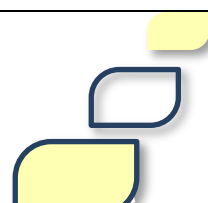

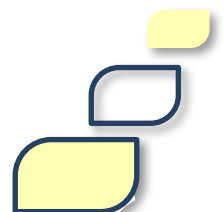

1.0 Fees 2020	2020 CSSA Membership Fees Tier 1 – \$6.84 + GST Tier 2 - \$5.55 + GST Tier 3 - \$3.07 + GST 2020 CIS Membership Fees Membership - \$6.40 + GST Events - \$25.66 inc GST → CSSA fee increase for 2020 in response to the 18% fee increase from CIS. → Only half the increase has been passed on to schools due to the late notice of the CIS fee increase. → CSSA shouldered the other half of the fee increase this year. The remaining increase will be passed on next year.

3.0 CIS Report <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Activity report - CSSA website - Paper Nominations	→ Primary – 526 nominated / 86 selected / 17% success → Secondary – 961 nominated / 70 selected / 7% success → Secondary selections down on last year. → CSSA website – changes to the CIS Section. 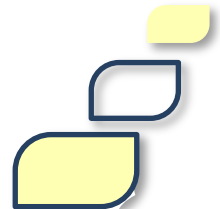

Oztag shorts

- Rules require matching singlets and shorts. Concerned raised regarding the necessity of shorts matching the shirts. Some students have multiple representative pairs but are not able to wear them as they do not match the rest of the team. Concerns about added cost.

Scheduling of Primary events

- Difficult for WCCS primary students to be involved in gala day events on a Wednesday due to sport. Fridays also difficult for other schools due to PSSA.

CSSA State Triathlon

- Triathlon teams event– suggestion to increase the team event swim length. Students who attend only for the swim are coming a long way for a relatively short event.
- Proposed Open water event prior to the commencement of the event. Charge students to enter to assist in the payment of the event.

CSSA State Netball

- Male student has expressed interest in participating in the primary GD.
- Would need to consider the implications for the boys and girls. Would need to address rules to assist in making the day safe. Eg 3 boys on the court who must be spread between the thirds of the court.
- Club netball boys are allowed to participate up until 10 / 12.
- Concerns as the Football GD same day as the netball GD. Suggestion to split the days.

NRL

- 29th Nov – NRL are funding Level 1 coaching course at Penrith.

- Revisit the rules regarding uniform requirements for oztag shorts.
- Copyright ran out this year so there may be changes to the ruling relating to Oztag uniforms

- Look at calendar to see if any primary events can be shifted from Wednesdays or Fridays

- Concerns that lengthening the swim may decrease the accessibility of the event for some students.

- Linda will discuss options with Triathlon convenor

- Suggestion for mixed division in primary.

- Suggestion for the possibility of mixed division in the secondary.

- COM to consider suggestions

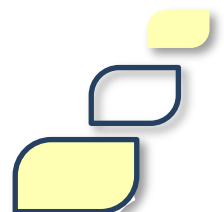

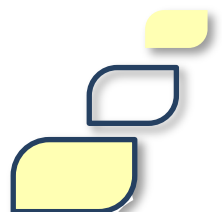
